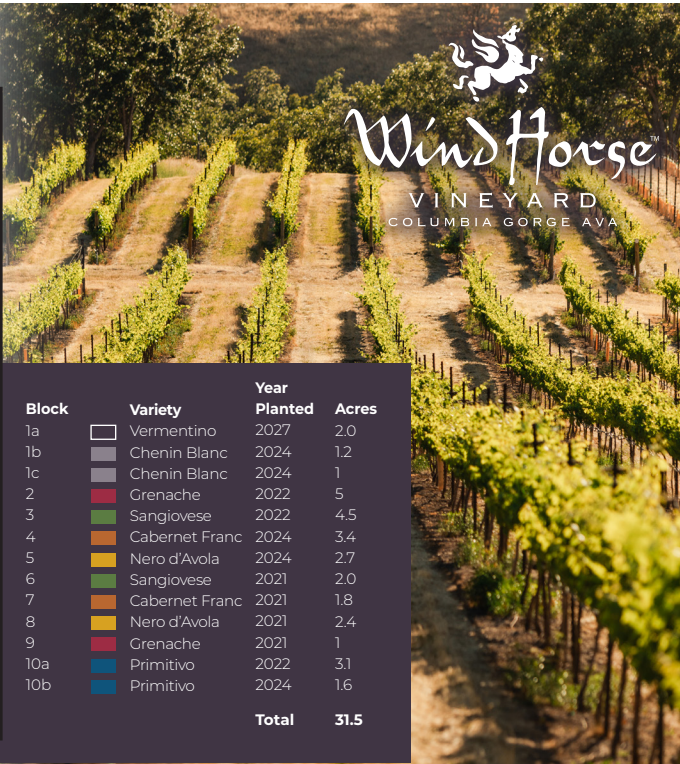

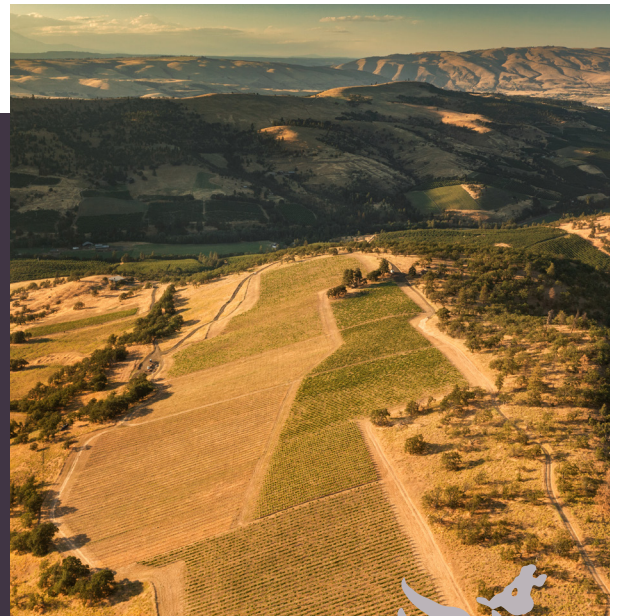

Windhorse Vineyard is LIVE and Salmon Safe Certified. We are certified sustainable in the LIVE program (Low Input Viticulture & Enology: <https://livecertified.org/>). Every year, every aspect of our farming practices & the materials we use, such as fertilizers, fungicides & pesticides, are logged, documented, & 3rd-party independently verified to meet international sustainability standards.

In addition, we meet or exceed the standards to be certified Salmon Safe (<https://salmonsafe.org/>), meaning that our farming practices protect water quality & maintain watershed health for anadromous fishes such as salmon & steelhead.
