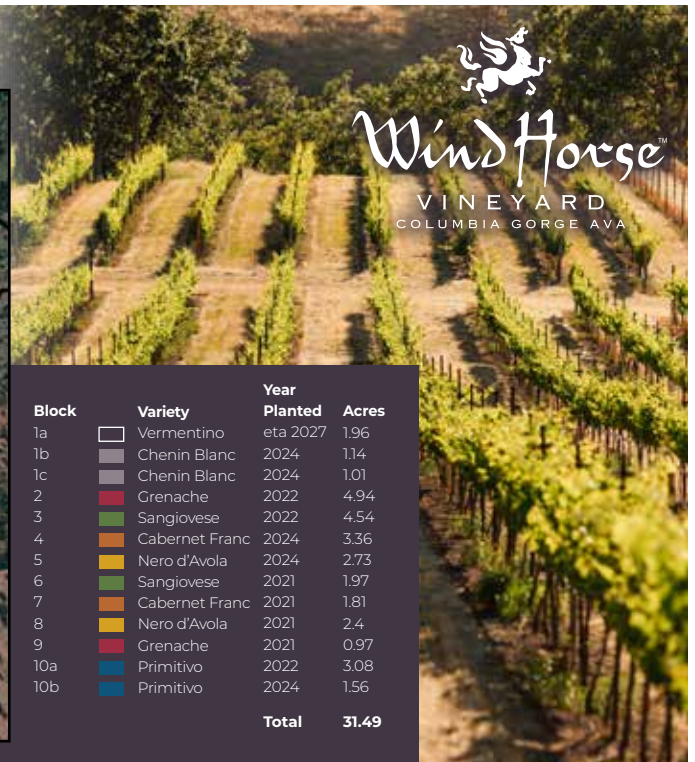

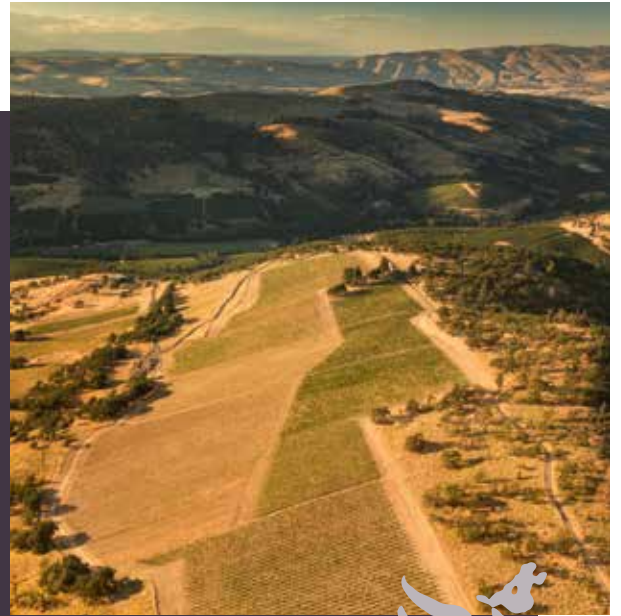

Windhorse Vineyard is LIVE and Salmon Safe Certified. We are certified sustainable in the LIVE program (Low Input Viticulture & Enology: <https://livecertified.org/>).
